Robyn noted that the heat in the Town Hall was left at a very high temperature when she arrived Wednesday morning. A note will be posted near the thermostat to leave thermostat at 70.

The December Treasurer's Report was reviewed and signed.

The Recommittal from Plodzick and Sandersen for Tax Collector Mark Secord, as Mark has retired was reviewed and signed by the Board. No issues were reported.

Robyn informed the Board the regular cleaning person for the Hall was sick this past weekend after confirming she would clean that Saturday; she became ill and didn't show up. The Hall had been privately rented for Saturday. The Board unanimously agreed not to collect money from this renter.

After an incident this past week involving a potential welfare emergency, the Board has discussed ways to improve communication for someone in a crisis.

The Board has reviewed Andy Brackett's Highway Dept preliminary Report for the Town Report.

Andy also provided an update, the backhoe blew a hydraulic line, halting the loading of sand and delaying Town plowing while repairs occurred.

Jared Mardin made a recommendation to change the housing unit for the water filter at the Town Hall to a larger one in efforts to rectify the sulfur smell. Andy will arrange with him a time.

The Board discussed the need to set the date for the Budget Meeting. Robyn will check with Jamie Dow from DRA to see that we are up to date with everything.
