Robyn reported that the Trustee of Trust Funds submitted their MS-9 Form.

Request for Elderly Tax Exemption was reviewed and tabled for additional information collection.

Minutes were signed for 2/6/19, 2/8/19, 2/12/19, and 2/13/19 meetings, and received for review for 2/20/19 meeting.

Errol reported on the possibility of Federal Grant funds for the Generator. There is a 50/50 grant available, Marilyn Booth is going to take point on writing the grant request, we will need to amend the warrant article to account for anticipated grant funds. Robyn will need to maintain a separate folder of only generator information with copies of everything to date related to it and everything going forward for review if the grant is awarded.

The Board discussed the upcoming Sugar on Snow Party and agreed to work with the Grange on dedication and future plans for Sugar on Snow Parties.

Gayle Clement came in to notarize the warrant articles so the Select Board could sign and get them posted. The Board discussed briefly the communications with Jamie Dow of the DRA during the course of the week. The Warrant and budget form MS-636 were not posted by the deadline as a result the town will be given a procedural defect letter and will need to have a second town meeting to be scheduled after the first is completed to ratify the first town meeting and clean up the defect. Robyn is working hard on getting the MS-636 completed with Jamie's help.
