

## **Select Board Meeting Minutes-June 17, 2020**

Presidential Pest Control came last Friday to treat the Town Hall for carpenter ants.

A motion was made by Jennifer Locke, in coordination with the Governor, the Town buildings will be open for business for groups of less than 50 with the continued recommendation of face masks, hand sanitizer, and social distancing, seconded by Denise Cartwright. By unanimous vote this motion passed. The Board will begin meeting in person at the Town Hall next week and will continue to stream online and through zoom until July 15.

Matthew Ramsey from the Census Bureau has requested the use of the Town Hall for their training August 4-8, the group size will be less than ten. The Board has agreed and will wave rental but will ask for cleaning fee.

Robyn will check with Lori Williams to see about cleaning the Hall and what covid precautions she intends to use.

Robyn will post the new Town Building update.

The Board tabled a discussion about the audit review until next week.

The stipend reimbursement for the First responders has been received, The Fire Chief is working on getting all the paper work in from the volunteers.

The question of whether people should be allowed to live in their campers and use that as a mailbox and for voter registration was discussed and the Board agreed that Denise Cartwright would take the discussion to the Planning Board's next meeting to discuss with them the current wording of the zoning ordinance.

Steve Santy's girlfriend called to follow up on the letter sent regarding the work done with out permission and the obstruction of Hawthorne Rd. She expressed she was unsure what the Board was asking. The Board will wait for a follow up from Harry McGovern before proceeding.
