He will be back Saturday and says he will fix the disrupted section of the Class VI Hawthorne Rd at that time. The Board has drafted a letter confirming what was offered. Robyn will finalize the letter Thursday for the Board to sign, then will send through postal mail as well as email.

John Turchetti expressed concerns over campers in Town. The Board informed him that this will be brought to the Planning Board for some clarification as they update the Zoning Ordinances.

Denise Cartwright proposed the Board continue zooming meeting as well as live at the Hall. The Board will look into what technology may be needed to make zooming successful and easy. Also, the Board confirmed that anything purchased by the Town for Covid-19 purposes can be reimbursed through GOFERR.

Gayle Clement has reached out about seat cushions for election officials. Robyn has extra at home she will donate.

Robyn will be forwarding to the Board, Town policies for review and updates.

Jon Swan of Dalton has reached out to other Towns for support against the landfill in Dalton. Landaffs Board will reach out to Lisbon and Lyman to see their stance on this as they are part of a tri-Town group on waste disposal.

Lori Williams who cleans the Town Hall has confirmed that she will continue to clean the Hall, she will forward a current contract.
