

Selectmen Meeting Minutes – July 24, 2019

OPEN SESSION:

The selectmen began their regularly scheduled meeting at 7:05PM

Andy Brackett- Andy attended to discuss the two red listed bridges in town, he questioned whether the Merrill Mountain Rd bridge was on the section of class six, Andy will verify and let the Select Board know. Andy will start researching what will be involved with repairing the bridges, including talking with Clough Construction and possibly other contractors, to get an understanding of the scope of work involved, primarily on the Merrill Mountain Road bridge. A town resident requested a sign for the Merrill Mountain Road indicating that it was a Dead End, the board agreed that it should be the same type of sign as on similar roads in town. The road crew also retrofitted the big plow truck to be able to take the calcium chloride tank, this will result in less wear and tear on the 1 ton.

Lisbon Water System- Scott Champagne wrote requesting a confirmation letter from the town of Landaff on the agreement between Landaff and Lisbon for the part of Landaff which is on Lisbon town water. Mike Ransmeier will contact Scott Champagne to determine exactly what they need from us, and Harry McGovern will research in the town reports for any supporting documentation.

Minutes- Signed the minutes from July 3, and June 26, and July 17th signed with one revision.

Country Comfort Fire Wood- There has been no response to the request for application for special exception. The Board will review the situation within the next week or two.

Meeting with Lisbon and Lyman- On Monday July 22, Landaff Select Board attended a meeting in Lisbon with the Lisbon and Lyman Select Boards to hear an update on the recycling center. The discussion centered on the reduction in recycling income. The three Boards made the decision to continue recycling at the current rate but to continue researching more efficient transportation setups, as the cost to transport from the recycling center is scheduled to increase significantly in the next few months.
