#### **Here is a schedule of events leading up to our 2011 Town Meeting.**

All citizens are encouraged to consider filing for Town offices. Our Boards and Commissions are 100% volunteer run, and the dedicated and hardworking citizens filling those positions improve the quality of life for all of us. Please consider whether it might be "your turn" to serve the Town as others have served us all over the years!

#### ***January 18***

Supervisors of the Checklist hold a session to update and correct the Checklist.

#### ***January 19-28***

#### **Filing period for town offices.**

This years' openings:

- Cathy Coyle's seat on the Trustees of Trust Funds
  - The Trustees oversee all the Town's long-term investments and the release of funds from those investments for Town functions.
- Brenda Dodge's seat on the Planning Board
  - Planning Board rules on subdivision, boundary changes, and development applications.  
Note: the Board of Selectmen issues building permits.
- Jim LaGrassa's seat on the Zoning Board of Adjustment
  - ZBA rules on requests for waiver from land use regulations and appeals of Planning Board decisions
- Tom Clement's seat on the Cemetery Trustees
  - Cemetery Trustees manage Landaff's seven Cemeteries  
(can you find them all on a map? If not, ask a current or past Trustee!)
- Sue O'Hearn and Richard Bronson's seats on the Conservation Commission
  - Provides oversight relating to resource, watershed, and land conservation within the Town.

**It is not known yet which of the people mentioned above plan to file to retain their positions on those boards and commissions.**

**February 1**

**Last day** for 25 or more voters or 2% of the voters in the town, whichever is less, to petition selectmen to include a warrant article.

**February 21**

**Last day** for selectmen to post warrant at town hall; warrant shall prescribe place, time of election, the time the polls are to open and close; warrant shall specify which items will be voted on by ballot.

**February 26**

Supervisors of the Checklist meet again for finalizing of Checklist before Town Meeting election.

**Last day** for town clerk to accept new voter registration applications

**March 7 (5:00 p.m.)**

Town clerk must be available to accept any completed absentee ballots filed in person at least between 3:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m.

**March 8**

**Town Meeting and Election Day.** Voters may register at the polls on election day. Deadline for town clerk to accept completed absentee ballots.

**March 11**

**Last day** for any person for whom a vote was cast to apply to town clerk for a recount. Clerk must be available at least between 3:00 – 5:00 p.m.

**March 15**

**Last day** for 10 voters of a town to petition clerk to recount ballots on any question printed on official ballot. Clerk must be available at least between 3:00 – 5:00 p.m.
